

Fact Sheet



- Close to 2,000 people are served by the Don Bosco Centers every day.
- The six centers that comprise Don Bosco are: Counseling Center, Charter High School, English as a Second Language Center, Family Support Center, Senior Center, and Youth Development Center.
- The Counseling Center provides mental health services to approximately 250 individuals each year, regardless of their ability to pay. In addition, five LINC counselors serve sites within the community.
- The Education Center is a fully accredited Charter High School enrolling 200 students and graduating approximately 90 students each May.
- The Don Bosco English-as-a-Second Language Center serves approximately 300 students a day from over 77 different countries.
- The Family Support Center provides support to nearly 11,000 individuals each year. This assistance includes food, clothing, help with rent and utilities, referrals, job counseling, and other case management services.
- The Senior Center provides lunches to more than 1,000 individuals every day. More than 400 of these meals are delivered to homebound seniors through Meals on Wheels.
- More than 700 youth participate in activities that include sports, volunteerism, group discussions, education and career counseling through Don Bosco's Youth Development Center.
